Selection of graduates will be made on the basis of district-wise quota and requirements in public sector schools across GB. 1- ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR INTERNS:

- I) Must be a permanent resident of Gilgit-Baltistan
- II) Must have completed 16 years of education ie 04 years of Bachelors program OR 02 Years Masters or MS Program in Science Subjects after 2020 from HEC recognized Institutions/Universities in the following disciplines.
 - a) BS/MS in Mathematics /Statistics/Economics
 - b) BS/MS in Physics/BE in any technology
 - c) BS/MS in chemistry (including food sciences)
 - d) BS/MS in Biology /Life Sciences (Zoology,Botany/Environmental Science/Agriculture Sciences/DVM)
 - e) BS/MS in Computer Sciences/IT/Software Engineering/Computer Engineering
- III) Must have secured second class of grade C in the qualifying degree.
- IV) Must not have benefited from any Government initiated internship program.
- V) Applicants completed degree program before 2020 will not be considered for this program.
- VI) The selected interns will perform teaching learning activities in schools and some of IT qualified interns will be engaged in offices on need basis.



SPECIAL CONSIDERATION:

- i) Ensure including 3% participation of differently-abled graduates.
- ii) District wise allocation of internee will be on a proportionate basis. In case of receiving less applications from any district against their quota, the remaining positions will be filled from the applicants of other districts, or the seats will be allocated to other districts where teacher's shortage is significantly high.
- iii) GBRSP reserves the right to cancel the candidature at any stage, if any document or information is found to be fraudulent or false.
